TERM 3 INFORMATION SHEET (03/2021)

Welcome back! We hope that you were able to make the most of the June holidays to spend quality time with your child/ward, as well as encourage revision of learning points from Semester 1.

Please refer to our letter dated 23 June 2021 for information and instructions for the "Resumption of School in Term 3". This letter will highlight key programmes and initiatives in the second half of 2021 as follows:

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In line with the national precautionary measures put in place, please be reminded of the following:

- Ensure that your child/ward is well before sending him/her to school.
- Ensure your child/ward brings his/her thermometer and Trace Together token/app to school.
- Strongly encourage your child/ward to use masks with high Bacterial Filtration Efficiency (BFE). These include 3-ply surgical masks and 2-layer reusable masks with filter insert.
- Please keep your child/ward at home and inform the school if any of the following applies:
 - Students with flu-like symptoms should stay away from school and seek medical attention immediately;
 - Household member (6 years old and above) living in the same household has flu-like symptoms;
 - o Household member living in the same household is issued with a QO/SHN/LOA; and
 - Household member living in the same household is required to undergo mandatory testing due to a COVID-19 cluster (this excludes household members who are healthcare workers or who come from other sectors that require rostered routine testing).

3. Semester 2 Timetable

2021 Semester 2 timetables are available for download via the school website under "Announcements" by 30 June 2021. The school will follow the new timetable starting **Term 3 Week 2, Tuesday 6 July 2021.** In Term 3 Week 1, the school will follow Semester 1's timetable (Day 1 - 5) in view of HBL days for Secondary 1 to 2 students on 28 – 30 June. As some adjustments to deployment were made for Semester 2, this arrangement will help students ease back into school with teachers whom they are familiar with.

Do note that the school will continue with staggered reporting and dismissal time as follow:

All students are to make their way to their classrooms before the Reporting Timing. Students will be considered late if they are not in their classrooms at the stipulated Reporting Time as indicated.

4. Attire & Grooming

The school conducts regular grooming checks to ensure that our students are appropriately attired and ready for learning. Class Mentors will issue reminders for grooming and students will be given sufficient time to rectify any issues. Term 3's grooming check will be conducted within the first week of school.

Students who are unable to adhere to school grooming rules may be sent home, or may be requested to have their grooming rectified on-the-spot. Please note that for students who still have inappropriate hair length or styles after repeated reminders, parents may be asked to bring the student for a suitable haircut before he/ she can return to school. Students may refer to their Student Handbook for the school rules related to grooming (pp.17-20)

Strategic Thrust 1 Learning

5. Secondary 2 PE Programme & Inter-Class Games

The Secondary 2 students will go through an 8-week Hip Hop Dance Programme during PE lessons in Term 3. Students will be briefed by their PE teachers. As this module will be taught by external instructors, a fee of \$10 will be deducted from students' Edusave accounts. The school will bear the remaining costs.

Pending updates to current SMMs, Inter-Class Games may take place in Term 3. Selected Secondary 1, 2 and 3 students will be invited to represent their class in Inter-Class Games (Netball, Handball and Ultimate Frisbee). Inter-Class Games will take place on Tuesdays (5 – 6pm), Thursdays (5 – 6pm).

6. Singapore Institute Technology (SIT) Community Challenge 2021

All Secondary 2 students will go through the SIT Community Challenge, a collaboration with the Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT) as part of the school's Applied Learning in Design, Technology & Engineering programme (ALP-DTE). Students will use Design Thinking skills to create innovative solutions to challenges faced by the elderly. Selected students will be shortlisted for the SIT Community Challenge Finals that will be held during the post-examination period in Term 4.

7. Secondary 1 to 3 Academic Programme & Schedule

Remediation

Subject Teachers for some subjects will organise remedial lessons for selected students based on their performance at the Secondary 1 & 3 Class Tests and Secondary 2 Mid-Year Examinations held in Semester 1. The identified students will be informed by their respective subject teachers by Term 3 Week 1.

Class Test 2

Class Test 2 will be held from 16-20 August 2021 during curriculum time. Students will receive the schedule by 31 July 2021. We encourage parents/guardians to work with your child/ward to put in place a regular revision schedule in the weeks leading up to the Class Tests.

Secondary 3 English Oral Examination

The Secondary 3 Express English Oral Examination will be held on 1 & 8 July 2021 and the Secondary 3 Normal (Academic) English Oral Examination will be held on 8 & 9 July 2021.

8. Secondary 4/5 Academic Programme & Schedule

To better prepare our students for the rigour of the examinations, we have put in place a series of academic programme to help them prepare for the National Examination with confidence.

Extended Academic Programme

Extended Academic Programme for the Secondary 4/5 will continue from 19 July – 6 August 2021 for 4NA students and 26 July – 20 August 2021 for 4EXP/5NA students. Students will be expected to stay in school for additional curriculum time until 6pm at latest. The students will receive the schedule at a later date

This will be the final checkpoint for the students before the National Examinations. We seek your support to help encourage your child and monitor his/her emotional well-being in the lead-up to and during the examination period.

9. Secondary 1 Blended Learning

We refer to the Blended Learning (BL) information shared in the End of Semester Term letter dated 16 May 2021. The school had originally scheduled BL to commence in Term 3 Week 3. However, with HBL conducted in Term 3 Week 1 for Secondary 1 students, the BL schedule will be adjusted to allow more in-school learning experiences for your child/ward. The school has introduced Student-Initiated Learning (SIL), part of BL, to our Secondary 1 students and will deepen their learning in this aspect with the distribution of the students' Personal Learning Device in Semester 2. More details on commencement of BL will be communicated at a later date.

10. Co-curricular Activities

CCA will resume at the regular time slots in Term 3, from Week 2 onwards. CCA attendance is an important part of holistic education and all students are to provide their teachers with medical certificates or parents' letters if they are not able to attend the sessions. With adherence to the National Safe Management guidelines, E-CCA will be conducted in Week 2. Physical sessions will only resume from Week 3.

11. Education & Career Guidance (ECG) Updates

We had earlier shared information on ITE EAE and DSA-JC in our End-of-Term Letter dated 16 May 2021. The Polytechnic Early Admission Exercise (EAE) for 'O'Level students, for admission to the polytechnics in Academic Year 2022, commences on 24 June 2021. Applications must be submitted online through the Poly EAE portal at https://eae.polytechnic.edu.sg.

To ensure the well-being of Poly EAE applicants, the institutions will conduct selections largely via electronic means. For a few courses, on-campus selection will still need to proceed as the selection process for these courses cannot be meaningfully replicated online. Safe management measures will be put in place for EAE applicants required to attend on-campus selection. The polytechnics will continue to monitor the national situation and will facilitate on-campus selection for more courses, if the situation allows.
