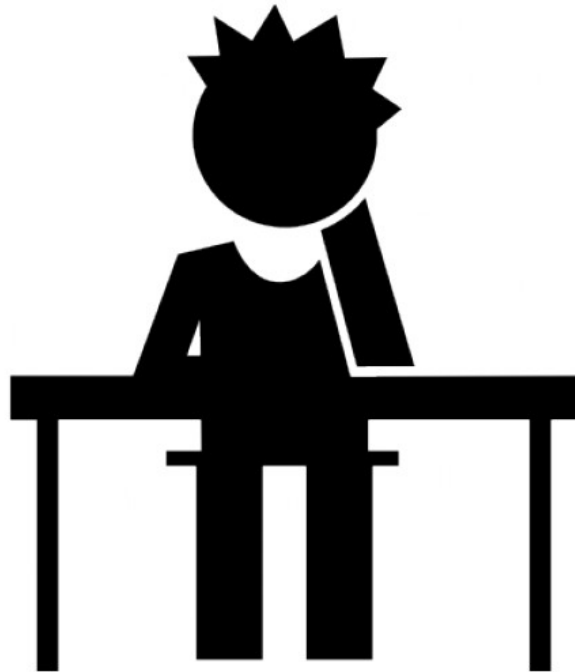

# 1. Be present

- Be present
  - ❑ Check in with your child on his / her progress
  - ❑ Have frequent communication and support your child in his / her journey this year
  - ❑ Check in with your child on school experience



## 2. Know your child

- Know your child – every child is different
  - ❑ What is the best learning environment for your child?
  - ❑ How does your child learn best? E.g. individual revision or small study groups
  - ❑ What are your child's interest and plans?
