2. Secondary 1 – 3 Post-Examination Programme & End-of-Year Academic Matters

Post-Examination Programme (25 – 27 October 2022)

In line with MOE's continuing efforts to enhance joy of learning and support holistic education, the school will be organising some enrichment activities for Secondary 1-3 students as part of their post-examination programme. More details will be provided for this programme at a later date.

End-of-Year Academic Matters (31 October – 4 November 2022)

To better prepare our students for 2023, there will be an academic programme for current Secondary 1-3 students.

Bridging Programme (for Secondary 1 NA, NT, 2 NA & Secondary 3 Exp students)

Secondary 1 and 2 students eligible to offer subjects at a more demanding level (Languages, Mathematics, Science, Humanities) at Secondary 2 and 3 respectively in 2023 will be required to attend a bridging programme. The programme focuses on teaching concepts and topics that were not covered in the previous syllabuses so that they can transit to Secondary 2 or 3 smoothly.

The Bridging Programme for all Secondary 3 Express students will focus on revising topics that students require additional support, as well as introducing students to some topics in the Secondary 4 syllabus. Please ensure that your child/ward attends all the lessons.

<u>Remediation Programme (for Secondary 1 – 3 students)</u>

Selected students who have not performed up to expectations in the End-of-Year Examinations will be required to attend a remediation programme. The programme will focus on revising knowledge and skills that students require additional support.

The remediation and bridging programme schedules, where applicable, will be given to students nearer the start date of the programme. Please help to ensure that your child/ward attends the programme.

Secondary 1 – 3 students currently attending remedials will continue to do so from the start of Term 4 Week 1 till the End-of-Year Examinations to ensure they receive the necessary academic support. Students are also encouraged to arrange for consultations with their teachers if they need help.

3. Graduation Day Ceremony (Friday, 30 September 2022)

The ceremony serves to mark a key milestone in the life of our graduating students as the school wishes them well in their endeavours beyond the national examinations. With the easing of safe management measures, we are pleased to invite parents for the ceremony this year. The ceremony will be held in the morning at the school hall. An invitation will be sent separately via Parent Gateway. As there will be a buffet reception at the end of the ceremony, we seek your help to respond to the invitation by Thursday, 15 September 2022 in order for the school to make any necessary arrangement. We look forward to having you celebrate this special day together with your child/ward.

4. Resumption of Co-Curricular Activities

To further support the re-establishing of peer and teacher-student relationships as well as having a proper closure to the year, physical CCA practices will resume from 12 October to 26 October 2022. The respective CCA teachers will be issuing a Letter of Notification to members regarding the November/December training schedule in preparation for 2023 National School Games & Singapore Youth Festival presentations.

5. End-of-Year Prize Presentation

To celebrate student successes and achievements, we will be presenting awards to students who have shown outstanding determination and resilience in overcoming challenges faced in their learning, as well as school life. The Prize Presentation will be held on Thursday, 27 October 2022. We hope this presentation can encourage the students for their effort and inspire their peers as well.

6. End-of-Year MTP Session

The Meet-the-Parents session scheduled on Friday, 28 October 2022 will be carried out for students and their parents via face-to-face sessions by default. Should it be necessary, a limited number of video-conferencing sessions can be arranged after the scheduled date.

7. Secondary 2 and 3 Student Leadership Training Programmes

These ongoing programmes are for selected Secondary 2 and 3 students who have shown exceptional leadership qualities and are part of the Aspiring Leaders Training Programme (Secondary 2) and the Inspiring Leaders' Training Programme (Secondary 3) for appointed Greendale Student Leaders. They are essential toward preparing our student leaders for their respective leadership roles and will be held in school on specific days towards the end of the year during the post-exam and school holiday periods. Specific details will be given to the selected students closer to the programme dates.

8. Sec 3 Work Experience Programme (7 - 11 November 2022)

The school partners various organisations to provide a Work Experience Programme for students who wish to understand more about a career sector of their interest. The programme is open to all Secondary 3 students and they may sign up for it in Term 4. Selected students will attend the work experience at their partner organisation from Monday, 7 November 2022 to Friday, 11 November 2022.
