TERM 2 INFORMATION SHEET (02/2022)

Welcome back! We hope that you were able to spend some quality time with your child/ward during the March holiday break. As we enter Term 2 of the school year, we hope it will be as enriching and fulfilling as the one in Term 1. In this information sheet, we will share some key updates and highlights of Term 2.

Academic Updates

2. Teaching & Learning Updates

Parents/ Guardians and students would have received their first Progress Report Card for 2022 at the end of Term 1. This constitutes 10-15% of the overall score for Secondary 1 to 3 students (see Student Handbook for details). Students are encouraged to identify and work on their strengths as well as areas of growth with their respective subject teachers for continuous improvement.

Selected students who have not performed up to expectations in Term 1 will be supported with remediation. They will be required to attend a remedial programme, starting **Monday**, **21 March 2022**. Similarly, students who show that they need extra support in Term 2 may be required to attend the remediation programme between **Tuesday**, **31 May 2022** and **Tuesday**, **7 June 2022**. The selected students will be informed of the remediation/ structured consultations schedule by their respective subject teachers.

Secondary 1 students who do well in Semester 1 for English, Mother Tongue, Mathematics and/or Science will be offered to take up the subject(s) at a More Demanding Level from Semester 2. These students may be required to attend the bridging programme between **Tuesday**, **31 May 2022** and **Tuesday**, **7 June 2022**. This programme serves to prepare the students better for lessons in Semester 2.

We will work closely with parents/ guardians to help our students learn and grow. We aim to focus on the student's holistic development, especially building resilience (including self-discipline as well as managing and overcoming setbacks) and nurturing a growth mind-set.

3. Academic Support Structure and Schedule

The school has planned the following programmes for our graduating students as we work together with them towards achieving excellence. We appreciate your support in partnering with the school to help your child/ward achieve academic excellence at the GCE 'O' and 'N' Level Examinations.

Extended Academic Programme (EAP)

The purpose of the EAP is to give all graduating students more time to consolidate their learning and prepare for the Mid-Year Examinations under the supervision and guidance of the teachers. This will prepare the students for the rigour of the examinations and ultimately, help them face the national examinations with confidence.

All lessons will be conducted after school between **Monday, 4 April 2022** and **Friday, 22 April 2022**. Please refer to Annex A for details.

June Academic Programme

The school also has a June Academic Programme schedule planned for all Secondary 4E/5N students. Selected Secondary 4NA students who are unable to meet their learning goals for the Mid-Year Examinations will be required to attend a Remediation Programme.

All lessons will be conducted between Tuesday, 31 May 2022 and Tuesday, 7 June 2022.

4. Mid-Year Examinations for Secondary 2, 4/5 students

The Mid-Year Examinations (written papers) will be conducted from **Friday, 29 April 2022** to **Wednesday, 11 May 2022**. Secondary 4/5 students will start their mid-year examination earlier on **Wednesday, 27 April 2022**.

The detailed examination timetable and circular listing the topics to be examined will be uploaded onto the school website in mid of Term 2. We encourage parents/guardians to work with your child/ward to put in place a regular revision schedule leading up to the examination. Please work with the school to monitor your child/ward's physical and emotional well-being and provide them with encouragement and support.

All CCA activities for Secondary 2 & 4/5 will be suspended from **Term 2 Week 6** onwards; Secondary 2 students will start their CCA activities after the examinations. CCA activities will continue for Secondary 1 & 3 students during this period. However, there will be adjustments made to the frequency of the activities. More details will be shared closer to the dates through their CCA teachers.

Students need not attend school on Marking Day on Thursday, 12 May 2022. Lessons will resume on Friday, 13 May 2022.

5. Resumption of National School Games

6. Student Leaders Investiture 2022

Each year, the school holds this ceremony to formally recognise incoming Student Councillors, Sports Leaders and CCA Leaders as well as to thank the outgoing student leaders for their service to the school. This event will be held on **Friday, 25 March 2022** as part of our CCE programme during curriculum time.

We hope that parents/ guardians of our student leaders will acknowledge the efforts and growth of the outgoing Student Leaders, and encourage the incoming Student Leaders as they take on greater responsibilities in their leadership journey

7. Secondary 2 Meet-The-Parents (MTP) Session

The Secondary 2 MTP will be held on **Friday, 25 March 2022** via Zoom Webinar. Log-in details of the webinar have been shared with parents/guardians of all Secondary 2 students separately. Parents/ guardians can expect to find out more about post-secondary pathways, subjects offered at Secondary 3 2023 as well as reminders on assessment details through the session. As this is a critical platform for the school to communicate with you on matters that will directly impact your child, parents/ guardians are strongly encouraged to attend the session together with your child/ ward.

8. Honours Day 2022 & Eladneerg IV

The school's Honours Day will be held on **Friday, 8 April 2022** to celebrate the success of our students. This year, we will also be showcasing our performing arts groups through our biennial concert - ELADNEERG IV. The 4th instalment of ELADNEERG will be shared with parents/ guardians via an online platform. The links to the award ceremony and ELADNEERG IV will be provided nearer the date.

Students will have light refreshments as part of the celebrations and will be dismissed as per usual Fridays at 12.30pm.

9. Post-Examination Activities – Level Camps

Level Camps are a signature event and a highlight of the Greendale Secondary School experience. Due to the uncertainty of the situation, the level camps were postponed from Term 1 to the Mid-Year Post Examination period. The three-day non-residential level camp will be held from **Monday**, 23 May 2022 to Wednesday, 25 May 2022. More details will be shared nearer the date.

10. Mid-Year Meet-The-Parents (MTP) Sessions

The mid-year MTP session is scheduled on **Thursday, 26 May 2022** for Secondary 3 students and on **Friday, 27 May 2022** for the rest of the levels. We will follow the national guidelines on safe management measures and will share more details nearer the date.
