General Matters

1. Semester 2 Timetable

Semester 2 timetables are available for download via the school website under "Announcements".

Please note that for Secondary 1 to 3 students, the Semester 2 HBL days will be on **25 – 28 July 2023** and **16 October 2023**. Please be assured that the school will continue to support our students during HBL Days. There will be no HBL days for Secondary 4 and 5 students. Lessons will start at **9am** and dismissal is as per all HBL days.

2. Attire and Grooming reminders

The school conducts regular grooming checks to ensure that our students are appropriately attired and ready for learning. Class Mentors will issue reminders for grooming and students will be given sufficient time to rectify any issues. Term 3's grooming check will be conducted on Monday, 26 June 2023, and students are to rectify all outstanding issues by the end of Week 1.

We also seek parents' help to ensure your child is appropriately dressed for school. Students may refer to their Student Handbook for the school rules related to grooming (pp.21-23). Please note that students who are unable to adhere to school grooming rules may be **sent home.**

Academic Updates

3. Academic Programme & Schedule

Secondary 1 – 3 Remedial & Structured Consultations

Subject teachers will organise afternoon programmes on Tuesdays and Thursdays for selected students starting Week 2 from **Tuesday, 4 July 2023** onwards. Remedial sessions aim to help students who have encountered difficulties in

meeting the stipulated academic requirements. The identified students will be notified by the respective subject teachers. Please refer to the schedule in Annex A.

Subject teachers may also invite other students to attend structured consultations on an ad hoc basis. Your child/ward will inform you if he/she has consultations with the teachers after school.

Secondary 4 & 5

To better prepare our students for the rigour of the examinations, we have put in place a series of academic programme to help them prepare for the National Examination with confidence.

This will be the final checkpoint for the students before the National Examinations. We seek your support to help encourage your child/ward and monitor his/her emotional well-being in the lead-up to and during the examination period.

4. Singapore Institute Technology (SIT) Community Challenge

As part of the school's Applied Learning Programme in Design, Technology & Engineering (ALP-DTE), all Secondary 2 students will go through the SIT Community Challenge, which is a collaboration between our school and SIT. Throughout Term 3, the Secondary 2 students will use Design Thinking skills to create innovative and sustainable solutions to real-world social issues and challenges. Selected students will be shortlisted for the SIT Community Challenge Finals that will be held in November.

Key Events and Activities

5. Games Carnival

To celebrate Youth Day, the annual Games Carnival will be held at Seng Kang Hockey Pitch on **Friday, 30 June 2023**. All students and staff are to report **directly** to the venue by 7.20am. The nearest LRT station is Farmway station. Buses

85, 102,110 and 374 stop at the nearest bus stop as well. All students and staff will be involved in sporting activities and there will be no lessons and CCAs in the afternoon. Dismissal time is as per normal school day.

6. Secondary 2 PE Programme & Inter-Class Games

Secondary 2 students will take part in the **National Physical Fitness Award (NAPFA) Standard in** Term 3. This is an MOE requirement. Students with valid medical exemption will be excused from the fitness assessment. Students will be required to stay back in school on **Tuesday, 11 July 2023** or **Thursday, 13 July 2023** to complete the 5 static components of NAPFA. The PE department will share the date(s) with the Secondary 2 students in due course.

Inter-Class Games for Secondary 1 and 2 students will take place in Term 3. Selected students will be invited to represent their class in the Inter-Class Games (Captain's Ball and Netball respectively). The Inter-Class Games will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5.00 – 6.00pm.

7. CCA Training Sessions

CCA will resume at the regular time slots in Term 3, from Week 1 onwards. CCA attendance is an important part of holistic education and all students are to provide their teachers with medical certificates or parents' letters if they are not able to attend the sessions.

8. Education and Careers Guidance Updates for Secondary 4/5

The ITE Early Admission Exercise (EAE), Direct School Admission (DSA)-JC and Polytechnic EAE for GCE N and O Level students have started. Students have attended preparation sessions and workshops with our ECG counsellor and teachers, and are strongly encouraged to visit the respective ITE/Poly/JC websites for more information.
