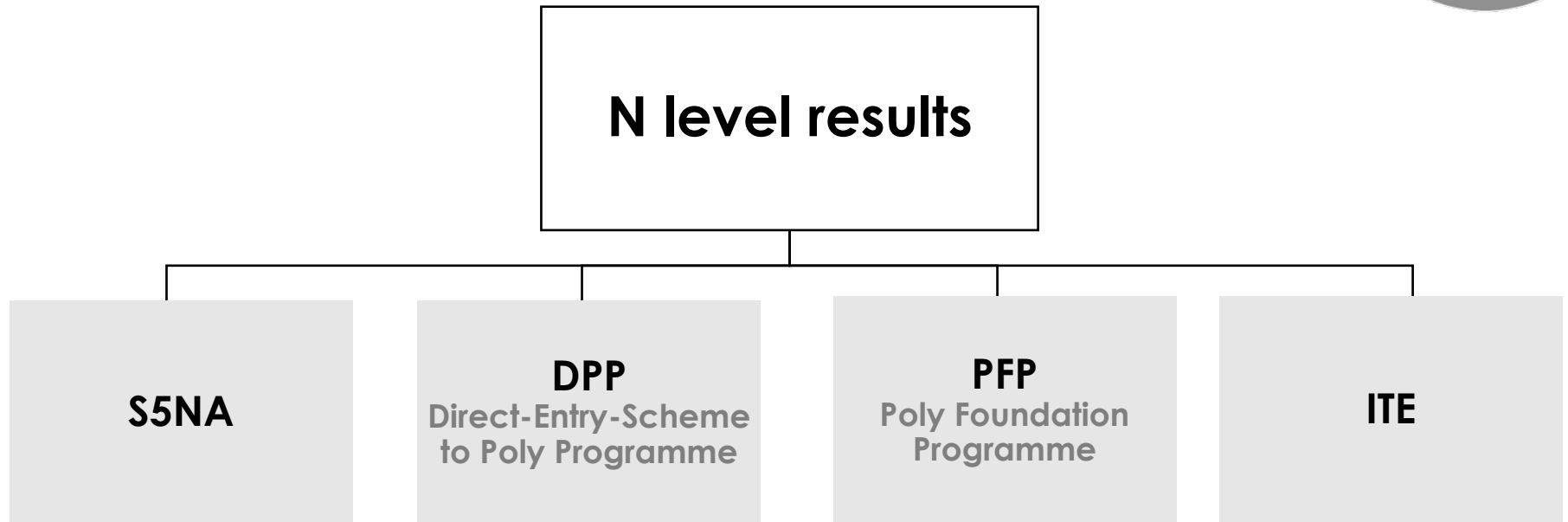

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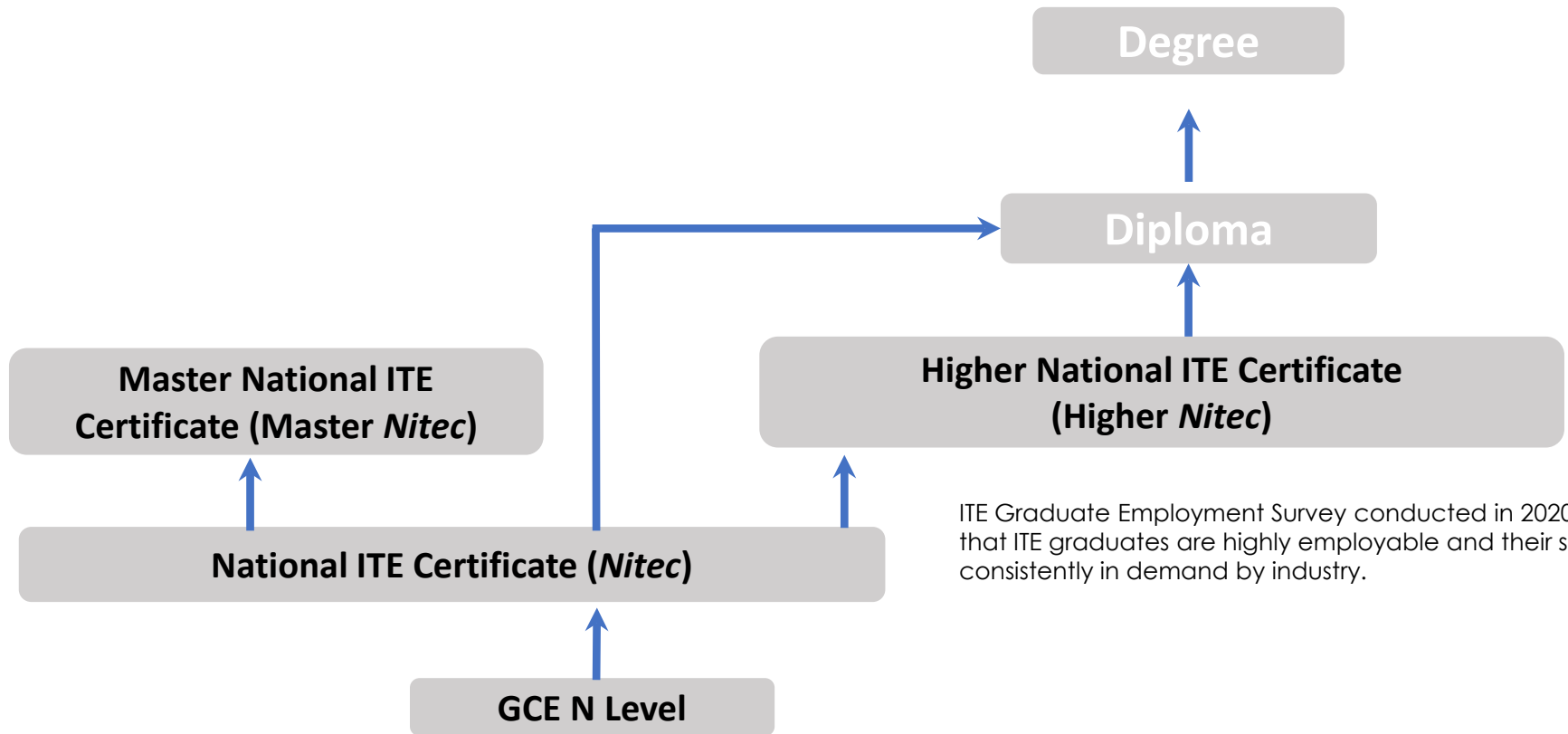
- **All PFP-bound students** are required to **attend Sec 5N(A) classes** up till the last Friday of January 2026, i.e. 30 January 2026.
- ***Certain that you DO NOT want to continue with Sec 5N(A) and is keen in DPP/PFP:**
 - **apply for the DPP.** If DPP is successful, start DPP (Jan 2026).
 - If eligible for PFP after GCE O-Level results released, apply for PFP and if successful, apply for withdrawal from the DPP and start PFP.

- ITE will also contact you on the status of your ITE EAE offer via mobile phone and email.
- Students with confirmed ITE EAE offers are expected to honour their EAE offers and **will not be eligible to participate in the JIE.**

Other Matters

School Graduation Certs



1. During Feb / Mar 2026 (check school website for information)
2. If you opt to go on to Sec 5 N(A), but change your mind shortly after, you will ONLY get your School Graduation Certificate in Feb / Mar 2027.
3. Loss of certificates: MOE and the school will not be able to replace these documents but students may get a certified true copy from MOE at an administrative fee chargeable.

Certificate Amendments



1. Check that your personal particulars (such as statutory names and Hanyu Pinyin names) are printed correctly on your certificate.
2. Any changes must be reported by **22 Dec 2025 (5:00 pm)**. Late request will not be considered.
3. There will be an administrative fee of \$50 for any request to amend the particulars.

Appeal for Review of Results



1. The fee is **\$S\$125 per subject** (inclusive of GST).
 2. No report will be provided for individual appeal.
 3. Closing date for appeal submissions is **22 Dec 2025 (5:00 pm)**
- Outcome of appeal is expected to be released by 27 January (2026)

REPEATING SEC 4NA:

Students who qualify and wish to apply to repeat S4 N(A) in 2026 are required to:

1. Submit your application via FormSG to arrange for a meeting with the Principal
2. **Still apply for ITE (Nitec courses) by 22 Dec 2025 (5:00 pm)**

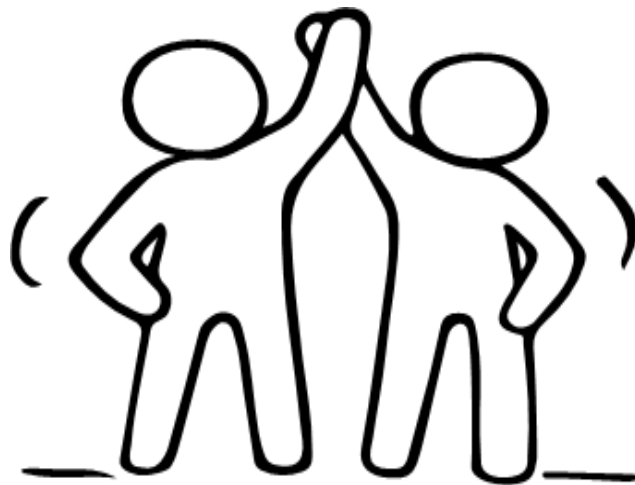
