Dear Parents/Guardians

We have almost come to the end of Term 3 and as we approach the last week of school and the upcoming September holidays, we would like to share with you the following:

1. Teachers' Day Celebration

The school will be celebrating Teachers' Day on Thursday, 2 September. Students will report to school as usual at 7:30am and there will be staggered dismissal times from 10:30am to 10:45am. School will resume on Monday, 13 September as Friday, 3 September is a school holiday. In appreciation of our teachers' efforts, we would like to invite you and your child to join the national Teachers' Day celebration to affirm our staff in Greendale through the Thank You Cher Gratitude Portal at <https://thankyoucher.edu.sg/>.

2. Overseas Travel

Students should continue to defer overseas travel unless it is permissible under the prevailing MOH travel advisory. The school will not be collecting travel declarations for the coming September Holidays. However, if students wish to travel, please take note of the following:

- i) Parents are to update the school of their plans to travel to countries/regions approved in the MOH travel advisory website
- ii) Be reminded that returning travellers from most regions would be placed on Stay Home Notice (SHN)
- iii) Be reminded to check the entry requirements imposed by the countries, and if approved, to take the necessary precautionary measures

3. Term 3 Progress Report for Secondary 1 to 3 and Holistic Development Profile (HDP) for Secondary 4N students

The assessment period for Secondary 1 to 3 and 4N students is completed. Students will receive their progress reports/HDP in Term 4. Subject teachers will be working closely with the students to identify their strengths and areas of growth in their learning.

4. CCA Stand down for Secondary 1 to 3 Students

CCA will stand down with effect from Thursday, 2 September and resume after the end-of-year examinations from Friday, 15 October.

5. September Holiday Homework for Secondary 1 to 3 Students

During the September holidays, subject teachers will assign September holiday homework to students to help them consolidate their knowledge and skills. Each subject may assign up to 1 hour of homework and the school ensures that the amount of homework given is reasonable and allows students to still have ample time for other activities with family and friends during the holidays. 6. Early Dismissal during GCE 'N' Level Listening Comprehension in Term 4 Wk 1

The GCE 'N' Level Listening Comprehension for English and Mother Tongue will be conducted in school on Monday, 13 September, and Tuesday, 14 September. Please note that Secondary 1 and 2 students will be dismissed at 2:20pm, and Secondary 3 students will be dismissed at 2:30pm on both days.
