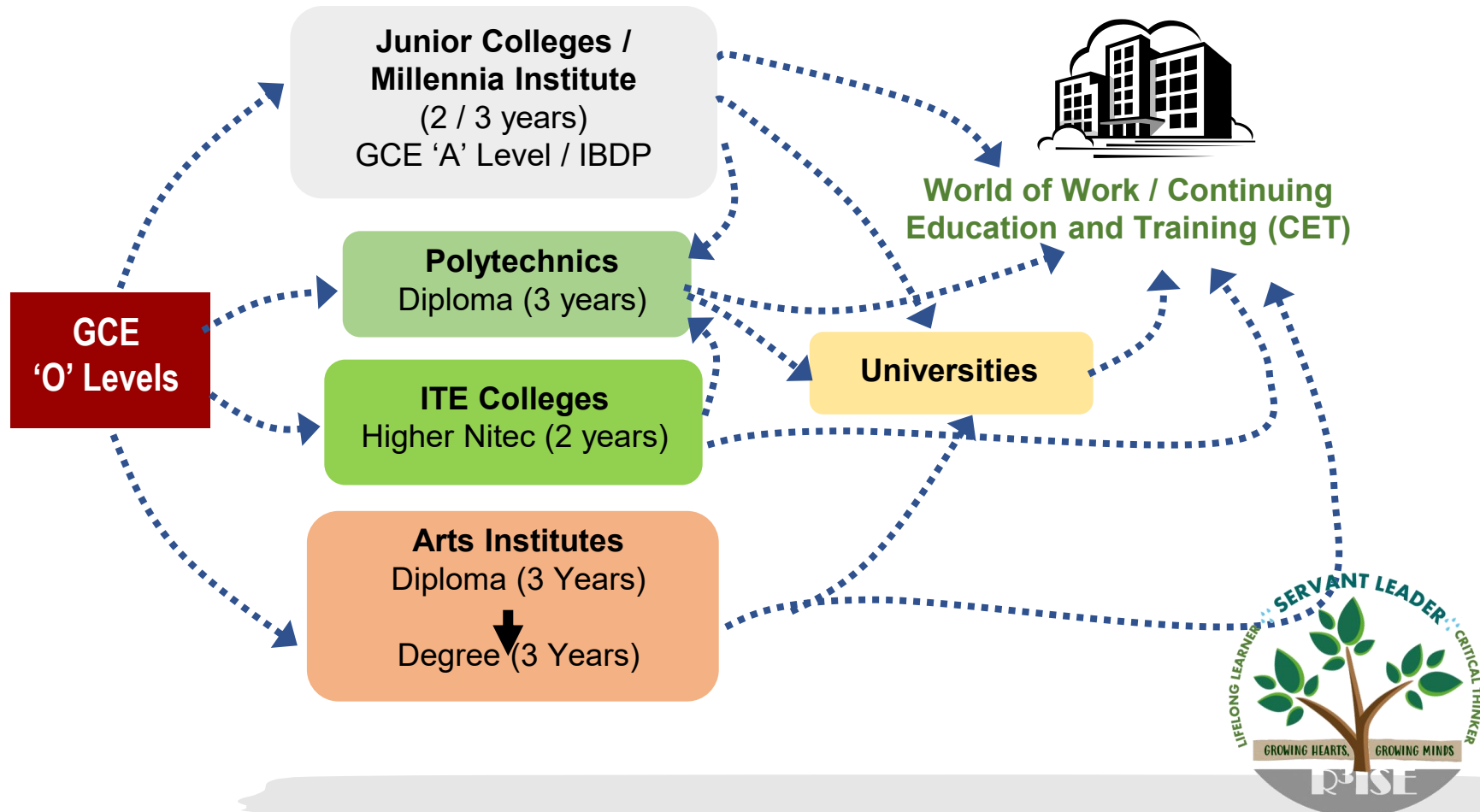

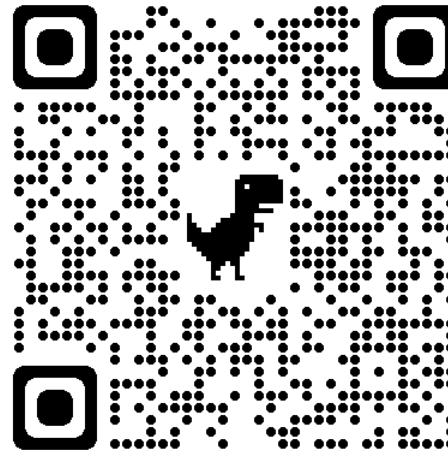

## HOW TO APPLY?



2. The JAE-IS is accessible through the JAE website at: [www.moe.gov.sg/jae](http://www.moe.gov.sg/jae)

Starting from **2:45pm** on O-Level results release day, Pupil Placement Services Branch (PPSB) will email students to inform them of their JAE eligibility. If the student is eligible, the same email will include **Form A** which contains gross aggregate scores for JC, MI, polytechnic and ITE aggregate types, and the JAE courses that they are eligible to apply.

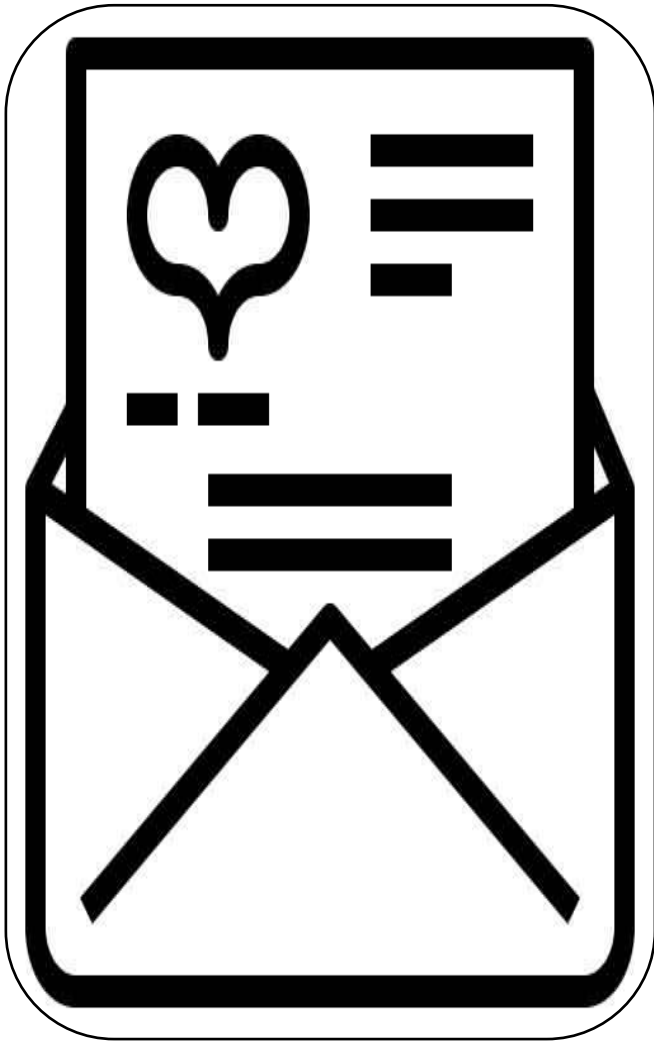
