Dear Parents/Guardians

RESUMPTION OF SCHOOL IN TERM 3

1. We trust that your child/ward has had a safe and meaningful school holiday. As Singapore moves into Phase 3 (Heightened Alert) with gradual easing of community Safe Management Measures (SMMs), we will progressively bring students back to school from 28 June 2021 in a careful and safe manner. We will share this letter with your child /ward through their Class Mentors today too.

Arrangements for Resumption of Classes

2. From 28 June 2021, our Secondary 3 to 5 students will return to school daily. Secondary 1 and 2 students will be on Home-Based Learning (HBL) till Wednesday, 30 June 2021, and will return to school from Thursday, 1 July 2021.
3. To provide students with time and support to re-acclimatise to school life, we will be using the **Semester 1 Timetable for the first week of school**. Students are also familiar with the current Timetable and teaching and learning routines.
4. Students will follow their Semester 2 timetable from Term 3 Week 2 onwards, and can download their Semester 2 timetables from 30 June 2021 for reference from the school website under "Announcements". For Secondary 1 and 2 students, their personalised timetables will be distributed in school on 1 July 2021.
5. Similar to arrangements during Full Home-Based Learning (HBL), Secondary 1 and 2 students on HBL will undertake a combination of online and offline learning, based on MOE guidelines. An overview of all learning for the day will be available at <https://go.gov.sg/hbl-assignments> by 2359 hrs the day before. Detailed lesson guides will also be available on SLS, including for offline work. Similarly, Class Mentors will be engaging your child/ward daily in the morning during the Full HBL period.
6. To welcome our students back and help ensure they are well-prepared for the resumption of school, we have planned the following readiness checks and programmes below:

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7. The school will commence e-CCA in Term 3 Week 2. In-person CCA will resume from Term 3 Week 3, with adherence to national safe management guidelines.

Safeguarding the Well-being of All Students

8. The school will implement prevailing Safe Management Measures (SMMs) and continue to enforce the use Trace-Together Only SafeEntry. Students are to have TraceTogether Token or Application (Activated) with them when in school as part of nationwide contact tracing effort.
9. In view that the current COVID-19 variants are more transmissible, we strongly encourage staff and students to use masks with high Bacterial Filtration Efficiency (BFE). These include 3-ply surgical masks and 2-layer reusable masks with filter insert.
10. To keep the school safe and open, we continue to seek the support and understanding parents and guardians on the implementation of the following measures:
- Students who are unwell (with symptoms of Acute Respiratory Infection) and/or registered a trigger temperature of 37.6 and above will be sent home.
 - Students who are unwell are to stay at home and seek immediate medical attention.
 - [UPDATED – revised age band]** Students staying in the same household as **individuals (6 years and above) with flu-like symptoms** will be placed on Approved Absence (AA) and be required to stay at home **until the unwell household member's COVID-19 test result (ART or PCR) is reported to be negative.**
 - [NEW]** If household members of students have to undergo **mandatory testing due to a COVID-19 cluster**, they will be placed on AA and required to stay at home until the individual's COVID-19 test result (ART or PCR) is reported to be negative. *This does not include students with household members who are healthcare workers and other sectors who undergo rostered routine testing.*
 - [NEW]** For students who have been on MC due to flu-like symptoms and are unable to produce evidence of a negative COVID-19 test result (ART or PCR) by the end of their MC, they will be placed on AA for a further 5 days after the date of expiry of their MC.

11. The school would like to thank parents and guardians for supporting the vaccination programme for students. The school has registered a high take-up rate of more than 90%. To encourage more students to come on board this vaccination programme, we will continue to engage parents who have missed the earlier opportunities to sign up.
12. You can look forward to our Term 3 Information Sheet to parents on 28 June 2021. Highlights will include updates on both academic and co-curricular programmes, as well as information on key school events.
